Art featured this month will be inspired by the artist's interpretations of the subjects' dreams and nightmares. **10% off each featured piece tagged with a moon symbol.**

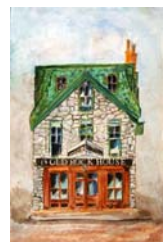
